## FAQ's

### Which roads will be closed?

Beginning Friday at 5:30 pm, the northbound lanes on Queens Road West at Wellesley will close to place the start/finish line. The remainder of the course will close at 6:45 pm. One lane on Queens Road West Northbound will reopen Saturday morning at 6:30 am.

### How do I exit the loop?

Residents should utilize the Charlotte Mecklenburg Police Department controlled entry and exit points. All roads remain open, but may travel in one direction. Please refer to the map included in this pamphlet for further details.

### I live on the course, how do I get out of my driveway?

When entering and exiting your driveway, please watch for riders. Traffic will be open the opposite direction of the riders. Please refer to the map included in this pamphlet for further details.

### What should I do in case of an emergency?

Please call 911. The event will operate on the 911 emergency protocols. For any emergency needs, all residents and participants should utilize this system. All emergency traffic will be controlled by the Charlotte Mecklenburg Police Department.

### Who do I call with a non-emergency question?

During the event, all non-emergency concerns may be addressed through our **helpline 833-988-7853**. Your call will activate the proper staff, police, or other municipal agency response.

### What if I have a family member who is coming into town during the event weekend? How can I make sure that they are able to find my house?

We do not want to discourage any family members from visiting. Guests will be able to enter and exit at designated points and you are welcome to print more resident passes for guests to use.

### Can I attend the event?

Absolutely! Please come out and enjoy the event. Join us for live entertainment, to learn more about our sponsors and beneficiaries, and to cheer on our riders, walkers and most importantly, cancer survivors!

### When will the event helpline be available?
